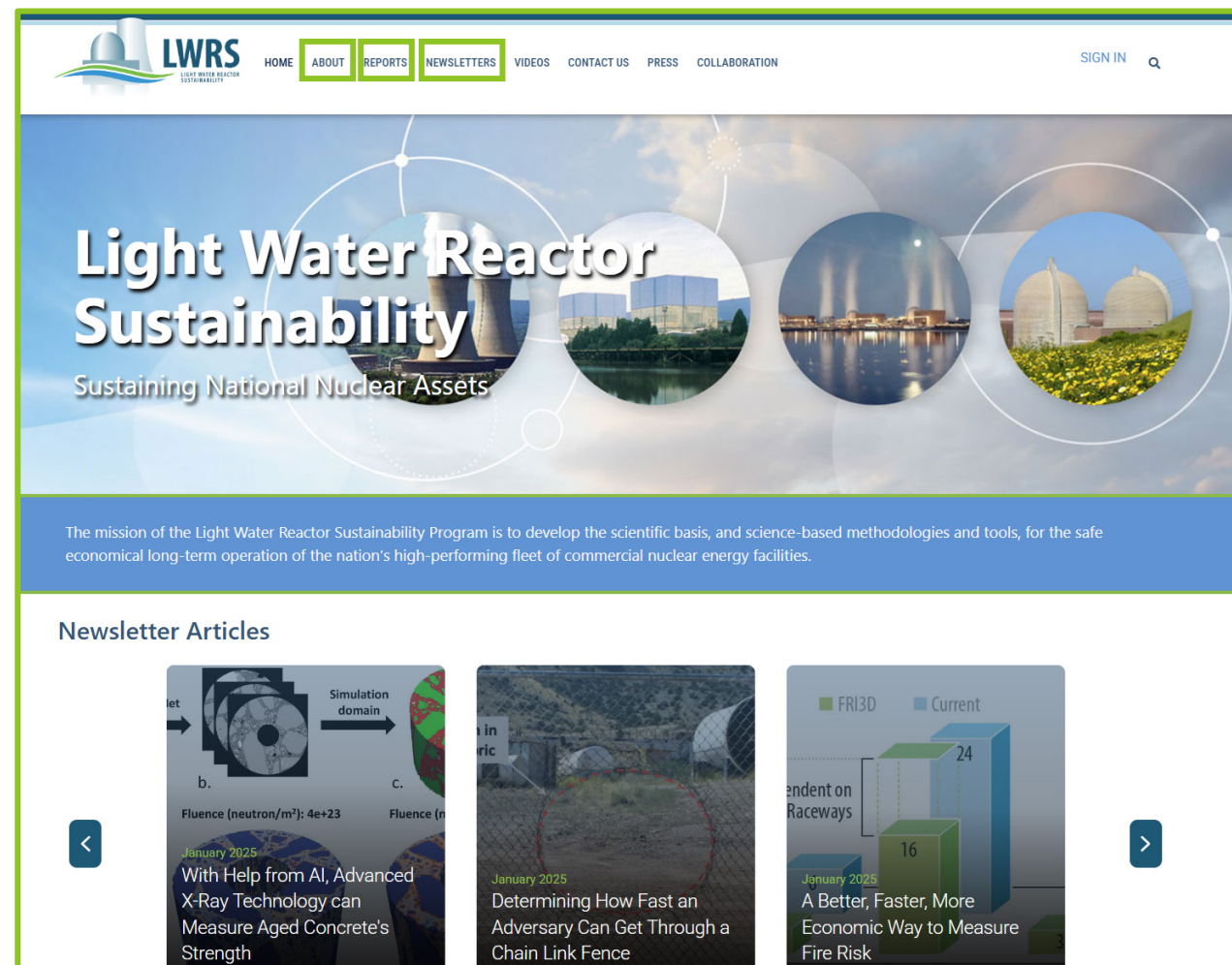

Use the search bar to quickly locate specific reports by title, author or topic.


